Renew the commitment to conservation and preservation of disappearing lands, waters, and wildlife, including the history and culture of The United States. 6. Ensure safe use of Natural Gas Energy and fracking to make America the world's clean energy superpower. 7. Support Carbon Dioxide Sequestration, which can greatly reduce CO2 emissions by capturing emissions and compressing them at 7,000 ft 8. Trump wants to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Make American energy dominance a primary goal of the United States. 2. Use and release \$50 trillion of previously stored resources of shale, oil, and natural gas, as well as clean coal. 3. Become and stay independent from importing energy from the OPEC cartel as well as any nations hostile to American interests. 4. Commence offshore and onshore leasing on federal lands, remove the moratorium on coal leasings, and open shale energy deposits. 5. Encourage the usage of American energy resources as well as natural gas which he claims will reduce energy emissions, the price of energy, as well as stimulate the American economy. 6. Destroy all job-destroying Obama executive actions by eliminating all barriers to responsible energy production, which according to Trump would create at least half a million jobs a year, \$30 billion in higher wages, and cheaper energy. 7. Focus on "real" environmental issues such as providing clean and safe drinking water, as opposed to "phony" environmental challenges. 8.
